**President Meeting Minutes from June 15th, 2016:**

- **Call to order**
  - Meeting called to order at 6:59 pm
  - Minutes from last meeting were approved
- **President's Report**
  - CJSA will be selecting a new executive administrator.
- **League Report**
  - U14/U13 – reminder that there are no premiere players allowed in RecPlus. District need to fine a club due to the rule break.
  - Problems scheduling Spring games. Need to discuss options for making the schedule more convenient for working with other sports. Doubling up weekends or ideas like that.
- **Old Business**
  - Age group issues – A lot of questions have been sent to Joe. There is really nothing the district can do about the age groups. U14 league will be U15 player. Just remember that they must be in 8<sup>th</sup> grade to qualify as a U15 player playing in U14.
  - Norwich United has dissolved as a club. Stoning Como may also be dissolving.
  - U9 Classic vs Recplus – The district will offer both but it will be up to the presidents to submit it correctly.
- **New Business**
  - Colchester RecPlus – A team has contacted District as Colchester is refusing to allow this team enter the district league. Colchester does not offer a RecPlus team into the district. Due to their rules. The players are registered through Colchester soccer. The district suggest that Colchester works out this issue internally to prevent succession of the club.
  - Premier players
    - Development players – Not rostered on a team. Today they are still considered part of Premier and would count to the 4 players. This is different than Development U12 and below. U19 Development team is a holding place for players that have not officially made the team but are able to play for the Premier players.

- # of premier players in Classic – Currently the district has the rule of a maximum number of 4 premier players for U13/14. Rule was put into the state several years ago when SE adopted it but has since been changed at the state level. Premier players have a premier team that is considered their primary team per the state. Shaun O’dea from EL is requesting that we eliminate the rule that will allow the EL players to continue playing for the town. \*\*\*Attach write up from email. Recommendation will be discussed and decided upon during the Spring Rules meeting. Proposal will be sent to all clubs to be voted on at the next meeting.

  - Proposed for labor day weekend. Rec, small sided. U6 and U8.
- Fee Increase starting Sept 1<sup>st</sup> for 16/17 players
